

In accordance with Territory Policy [3.5 Episcopal Remuneration](#), and aligned with Council of the North guidelines, compensation as of June 2019 is as follows:

Base Stipend	34,826.75
Years of service are calculated at the maximum number of years	6,735.00
Bishop's Responsibility allowance	8,000.00
Housing allowance is based on the clergy amount in the parish where the bishop resides plus up to 20% (e.g. in Kamloops)	21,600.00
TOTAL (EXCLUDING BENEFITS)	71,161.75

The Territory Bishop will receive up to three (3) weeks paid leave for approved Continuing Education in keeping with the National Church Guidelines and Standards for Continuing Education. (Continuing Education is not to be considered part of Annual Vacation).

Holidays and Continuing Education leave are to be scheduled in such a way that the Bishop is away for no more than five consecutive weeks at a time. Exceptions shall be with the approval of the Administration Committee.
